

VT4 100W, 105W, 150W, and 200W Models Installation Instructions

NOTICE: Green ground wire is provided in proper location. Do not relocate.

SAFETY: This fixture must be wired in accordance with the National Electrical Code and applicable local codes and ordinances. Proper grounding is required to ensure personal safety. Carefully observe grounding procedure under installation section.

APPLICATIONS: This lighting fixture is designed for indoor lighting applications, and should not be used in an area with limited ventilation or inside high ambient temperature enclosures. It must be stored in a dry location prior to installation.

ATTENTION RECEIVING DEPARTMENT: Note actual fixture description of any shortage or noticeable damage on delivery receipt. File claim for common carrier (LTL) directly with carrier. Claims for concealed damage must be filed within 15 days of delivery. All damaged material, complete with original packaging must be retained.

IMPORTANT: The luminaire has a 4kV surge protector installed in the driver. If the the luminaire is installed in industrial buildings or places with unstable voltage, it is recommended to have an additional 10kV surge protection device installed.

NOTE: VT4-105W-4P-3CCT-UD has a surge protection of 10kV.

SURFACE MOUNT INSTALLATION

- 1. Use the provided mounting screws to secure the Surface Mounting Brackets to Mounting Surface (Fig.1). See Table 1 for the recommended Surface Mounting Bracket distance from center to center.
- 2. Attach the back of the luminaire's housing into the mounting brackets (Fig. 2). Ensure the LED tray is secured with the safety tethers (Fig. 3). Unlatch the Lens and Tray Assembly from Housing.
- 3. Install the cable gland to the end of the housing (Fig. 4). Insert the flexible power cable (not included) through the cable gland allowing for sufficient length of stripped cable inside the housing and tighten the gland. Insert supplied plug into unused conduit hole.
- 4. Make electrical connections (see wiring instruction on reverse).
- 5. Secure the lens and tray assembly to housing by clamping down the latch.
- 6. Fasten and secure lens cover using latches (Fig. 5).

7. Restore power to the luminaire.



SUSPENSION MOUNTING INSTALLATION

- 1. Secure surface mounting brackets to housing (Fig.6).
- 2. Install the V-Hook on surface mounting bracket (Fig.6).
- 3. To suspend housing, connect each V-Hook to two equal lengths of chain (not supplied) and/or appropriate hardware suitable for mounting surface. Chains must be suitable to support four times the weight of the fixture.



WIRING INSTRUCTION

Make the necessary wiring connections as shown in the wiring diagram (Fig. 7).

The polarity of the dimming connections is important to ensure the performance as desired.

If not using the dimming functionality, DO NOT connect the Driver Dim+ (Violet) and the Driver DIM- (Grey). Insert the liquid tight conduit (not included) and liquid tight conduit fitting into desired conduit hole located on the end of the housing. Insert supplied plug into unused conduit hole.


