
Package Contents

Hand tighten until snug.

Turn off electricity at circuit breaker or main fuse box before installation. Consult a licensed electrician if in doubt. These instructions are provided for your safety. It is very important you read them completely before installing the fixture.

We strongly recommend that a licensed, professional electrician perform the installation.

Disconnect fixture from power source before replacing bulbs. Make sure bulbs are given sufficient time to cool before removal.



STEP 2 - Attach Crossbar to Outlet Box. A. Pass the supply wires through the Crossbar (EE). Attach the Crossbar (EE) to the Outlet Box (CC) with the head of the Green Ground Screw facing you. Secure it with Outlet Box Screws (not included). Tighten until snug. Outlet Box Supply Wires with Outlet Box Screws Ground Wire

STEP 3 - Fit Ceiling Canopy to Crossbar Assembly

A. Fit the ceiling canopy to Mounting Screws (DD) and secure with Decorative Caps (AA). Note: The ceiling canopy should be snug against the ceiling and the Decorative Caps(AA). If not, adjust the length of the Mounting Screws (DD) by unscrewing the Hex Nut -DD and Lock Washer and Ceiling then screwing Mounting Canopy Screws (DD) in or out of the Crossbar (EE) until the correct length is achieved. Once the ceiling canopy is secure, remove the Decorative Caps (AA) and ceiling canopy and proceed to Step 4. Figure 3
