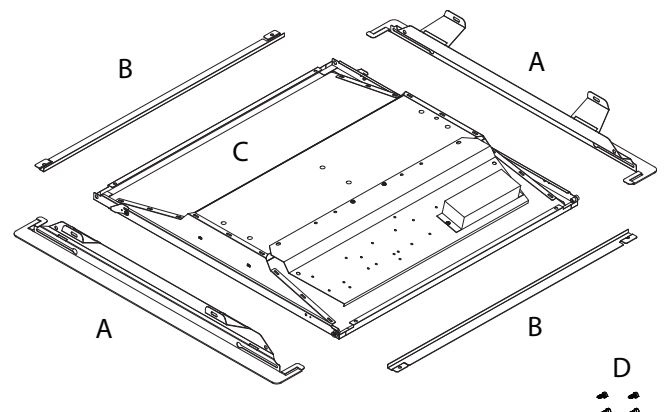

- D:** Self-tapping Screws - 4pcs



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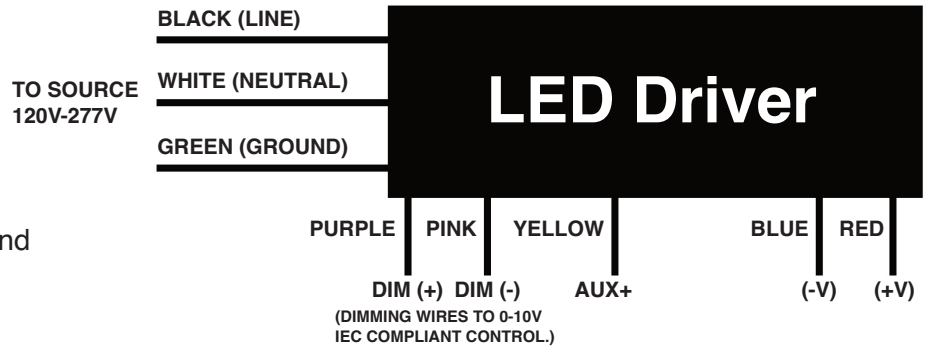


General Wiring Diagram

Connecting panels to AC source supply:
All units must be individually connected to the AC supply. (120-277 VAC)

Black = Line, White = Neutral, Green = Ground



Installation & Operation

1. Prior to installation, disconnect all incoming power to the luminaire. Remove the existing hardware (lens/lens frame or parabolic louver, reflectors/ballast covers, brackets, lamps/lamp holders, etc.). Leave the supply and grounding leads in place. (See **Fig. 1**) **NOTE:** Follow all federal and local regulations when disposing of lamps and removed components.
2. Install the two (2) end plates to each end of the existing luminaire by placing them between the fixture and T-grid. Secure them with four (4) self-tapping screws. (See **Fig. 2, Fig. 2A**)
3. If needed, install the side plates between the fixture and T-grid, there are two tabs to allow for placing the side brackets into the slot of the end plates. (See **Fig. 3**)
4. Place the hinges of the retrofit luminaire body into the keyholes of the end plates, slide the luminaire body horizontally to the end of the slots. (See **Fig. 4, Fig. 4A**).
5. Hook the safety cables into the holes on the end plates, and use the provided wire nuts to connect the wire leads of the troffer kits to the main power leads (Black-Live, White-Neutral, Green-Grounding). (See **Fig. 5, Fig. 5A**)
6. Push the retrofit troffer up into place and secure it with the locking latches on each end of the luminaire body. (See **Fig. 6**)

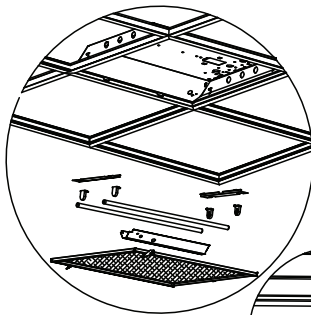

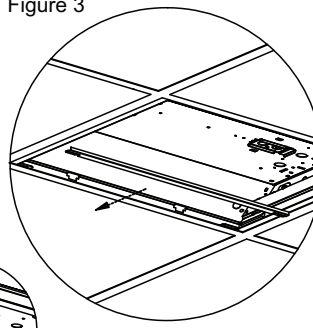

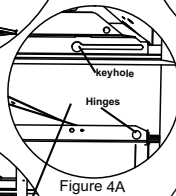
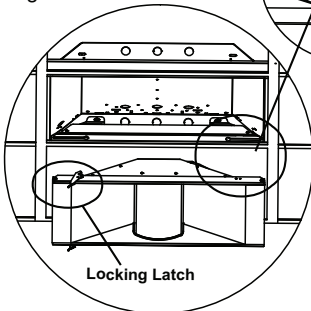

The end users may adjust the color temperature and lumen output respectively by the two DIP switch. Select a wattage and color temperature by sliding switch left or right respectively to the desired value.
