## INSTALLATION

- 1. Turn off the power supply.
- 2. Determine the desired location for each fixture, drill the wireway hole at this time. Hold the fixture in correct direction, lead the wire through the wireway hole, secure with screws.
- 3. Strip the 2 leads from the fixture pigtail wire. Connect the leads from the fixture to the main low voltage supply cable leads.




FIG.A Installation on Wall (most common use)




FIG.B Drill Template
